On Saturday, January 16th, 2021, at approximately 4:56 PM, Ithaca Police Officers responded to Ithaca Police Headquarters for a walk-in complaint of a Robbery.

Two victims reported being in a residence in the 300 Block of South Cayuga Street at approximately 4:30 PM on this date when multiple unidentified suspects entered the residence without permission with one displaying a firearm. Both victims were ordered by the suspect with the firearm to turn over several items to include an undisclosed amount of United States currency. At one point during the incident the suspect with the firearm reportedly struck one victim in the face with said weapon causing minor non-life-threatening injuries. Both victims were eventually able to escape the residence through an open window at which time they fled the area on foot to Ithaca Police Headquarters.

Ithaca Police Officers responded back to the incident location at which time a perimeter was established. A subsequent search for suspects inside of the residence and nearby in surrounding areas yielded negative results. The scene was secured by members of the Patrol Division and same was eventually processed by members of the Ithaca Police Crime Scene Unit.

At this time an investigation into this incident is ongoing and as a result no further information will be released. Anyone with information regarding this matter is encouraged to contact the Ithaca Police Department by any of the following means and those who wish to remain anonymous may do so.
