On February 17th, 2021 at 6:07 pm the Ithaca Police Department Patrol Division responded to a reported stabbing at a residence in the 400 block of Cascadilla Street. Initial officers on scene located a male victim that had sustained a stab wound to his torso. The victim was treated on scene by Bangs Ambulance and Ithaca Fire Department and was subsequently flown to a regional trauma center. The injuries are not believed to be life threatening.

The victim was unable to provide officers with a suspect description while on scene. It is believed that the victim and suspect are likely known to each other and that this is not a random act of violence.

At this time there is no evidence to suggest that this incident is connected to the shooting incident that occurred nearby this location on February 16th, 2021.

The investigation is ongoing, and the Ithaca Police Department is asking that anyone who was in area during the incident or anyone who resides in the area that may have surveillance footage to contact the Ithaca Police Investigative Division. Persons can remain anonymous if they wish to do so.
