

2021 CASS PARK Roller Skate COVID PROTOCOLS

You may not enter the building and/or rink if you answer yes to any of the following questions...

1. Have you or anyone in your skating group had COVID-19 related symptoms in the past 24 hours including but not limited to fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, nausea, chills, body aches, congestion/runny nose, diarrhea, loss of smell/taste?
2. Have you or anyone in your skating group been diagnosed with or have had close contact with anyone diagnosed with, COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
3. Have you been directed to quarantine, isolate or self-monitor at home for COVID-19 by any doctor, hospital or health agency in the past 14 days?
 - 3a. **If yes**, have you been released by that medical professional?
4. Have you or anyone in your skating group traveled outside the United States?
 - 4a. **If yes**, have you or they completed the requirements by **NYS** for testing or quarantine?

Masks must be worn at all times in the building and in the rink (except for those under 2 years of age).

Social distancing (minimum of 6ft) must be maintained (except for members of the same household).

Please comply with all COVID19 signs on site during your visit.

You may enter the building **no more than 10 minutes prior** to your session **and must leave the building no more than 10 minutes after** your session has ended. Those arriving prior to 10 minutes to their session should remain in their cars or remain outside the building.

Roller Skate Sessions will be initially limited to 60 public skaters. All skaters are encouraged to use our [online registration](#) to pre-purchase your session admission and your skate rental, if desired. There will be walk up spots available **if pre-registration has not reached capacity** prior to the start of each session.

Child/Student skaters may be accompanied by no more than one non skating adult (spectator). Adult skaters may not be accompanied by any non-skating spectators. We ask that caregivers/spectators stay in the open air rink or wait outside the building rather than in the building.

Rental Skates will be sanitized after each use.

The Cass Park concession will not sell food or drink until further notice.
