IPD Use of Force 2021

Types of force are tracked per defendant/subject and multiple types of force could be used in the same incident.

Verbal Commands noted in the graph below (71) were used prior to all instances of force except one. This one instance not using a verbal command involved a justified K9 display.

Please note that all types of force in the data chart below are the types of force that are reported to NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services per their guidelines, except for Verbal Commands, Compliance Techniques, and K9 Involvement. These types of force are tracked per IPD police and are not reported NYS DCJS.

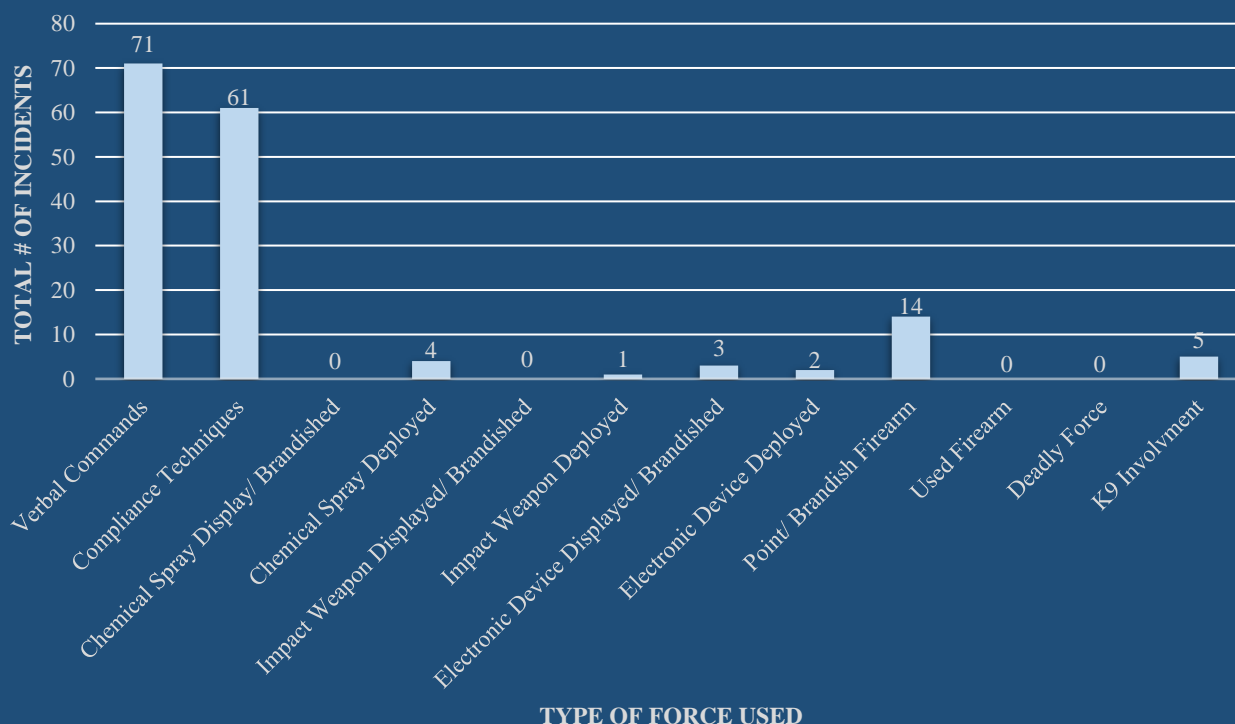
Demographic breakdowns for sex, race, and ethnicity are on the following page. The terminology used is based on what is required and submitted to NYS DCJS.

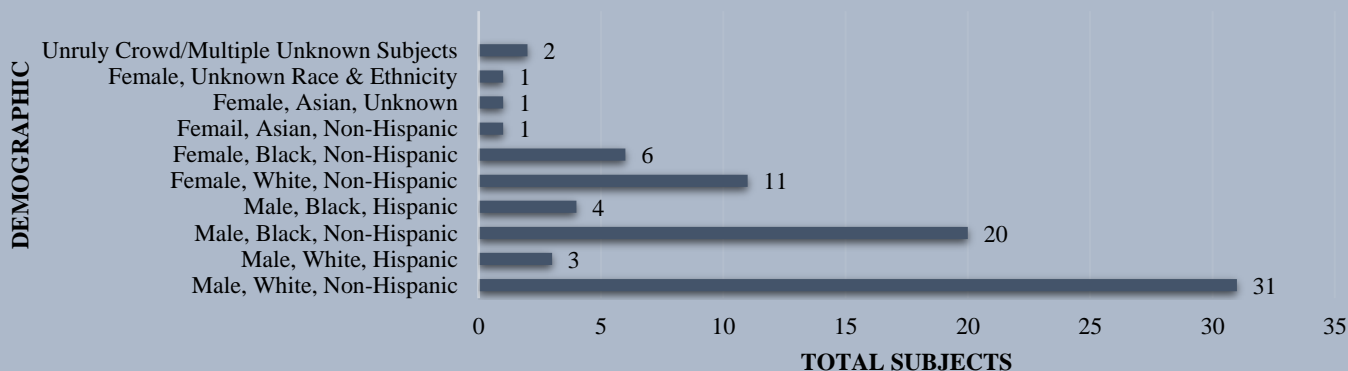

Types of Force Used by IPD in 2021

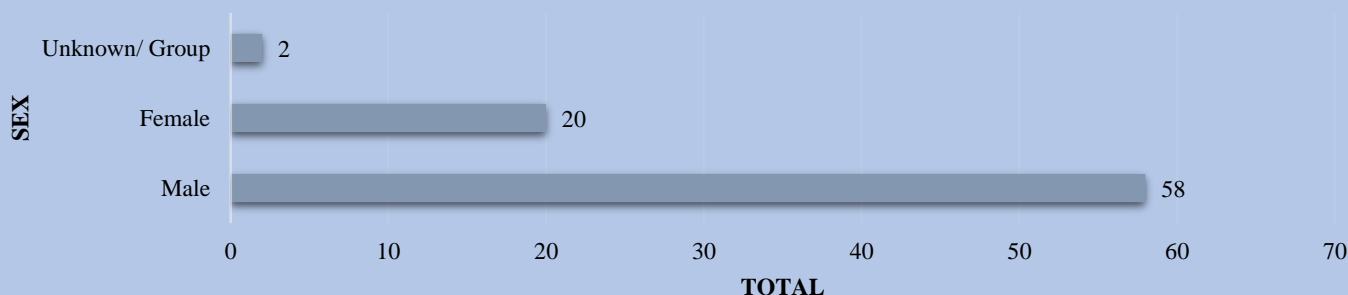

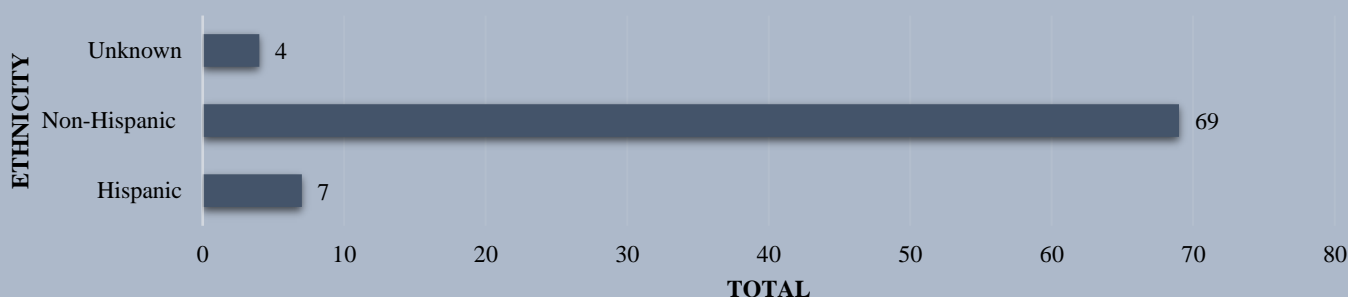
Breakdown of Subjects



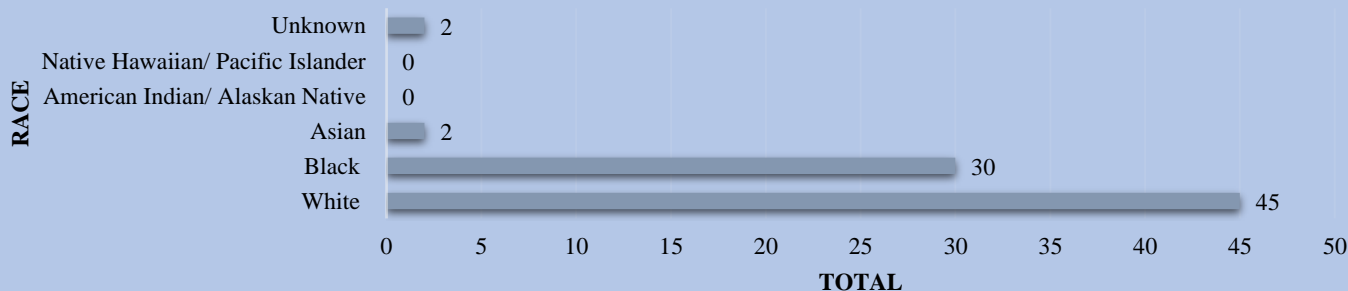
Use of Force by Sex

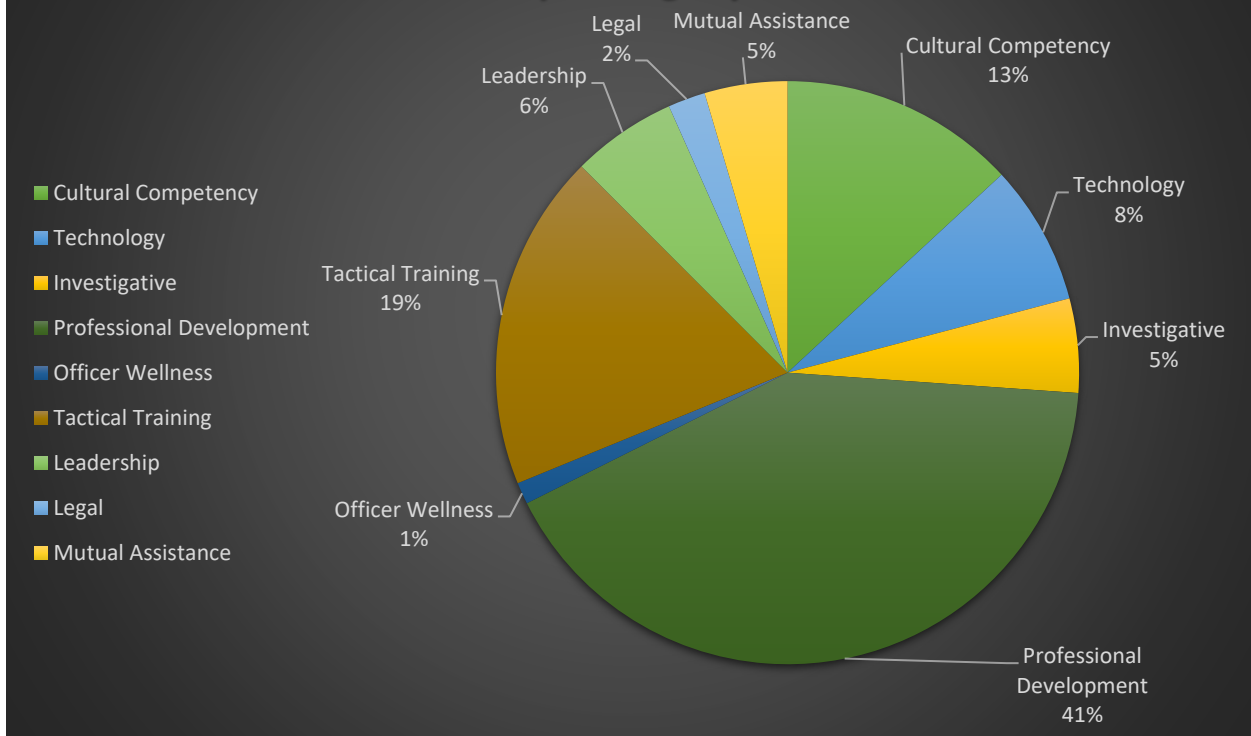
